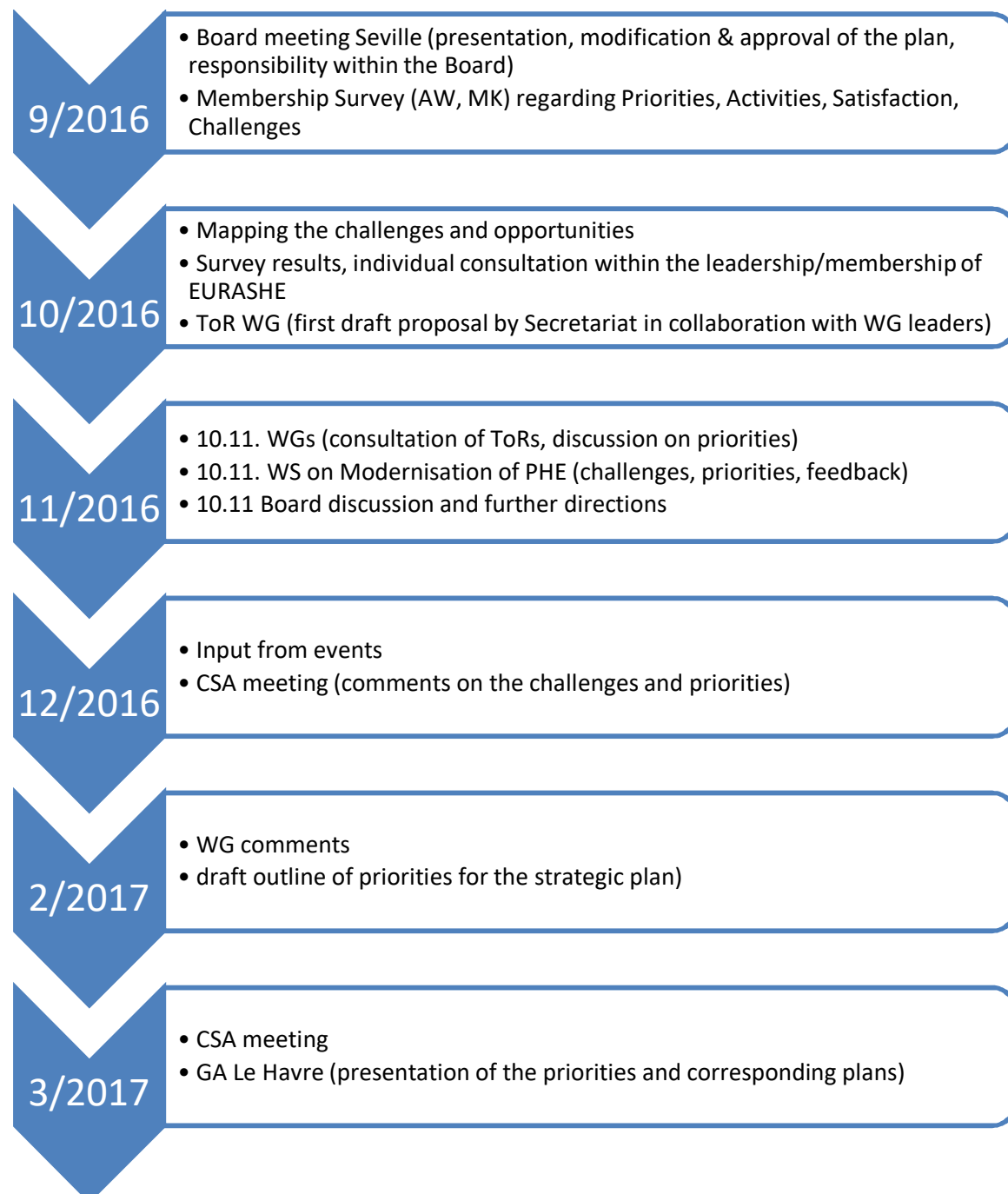


## Strategic plan 2017-2020 development update

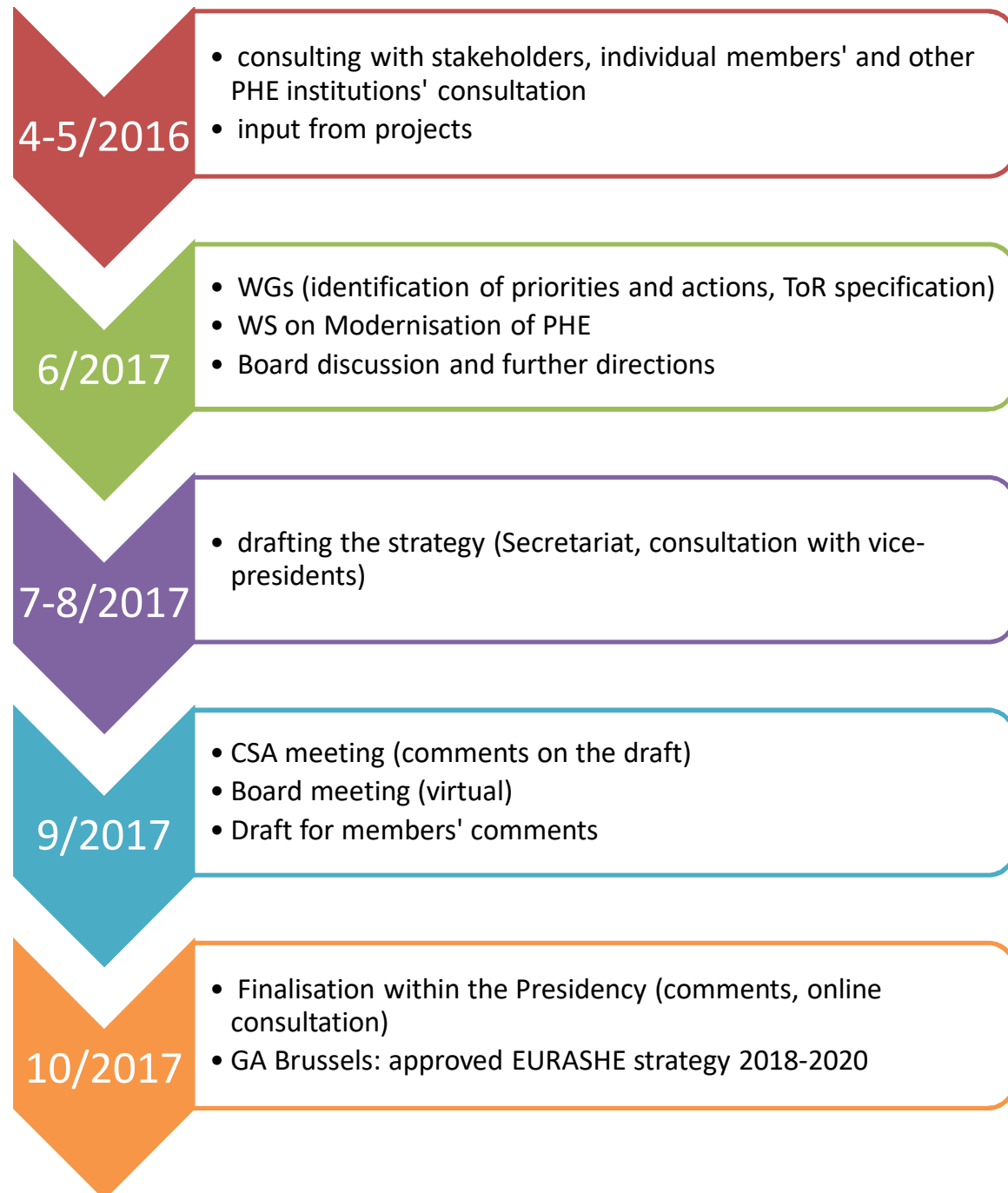
EURASHE has agreed to review its strategic priorities. The approach has been based on input from EURASHE internal bodies, discussions within working groups, conclusions of the EURASHE events, as well as documents and consultation with external stakeholders including the Committee for Strategic Advice.

The Secretary General is in charge of coordination of the process, however the role of the President is indisputable and the Board has nominated two Vice-presidents to supervise the process and outcomes.

It appears that such efforts might correspond with the EC plans for reviewing the HE modernisation policy. UAS and other institutions of professional higher education are expected to play even more substantial role.

The review of the priorities will also indicate themes which should be highlighted in EURASHE policies for the 2018 ministerial conference, but also reflect the shift towards other themes (e.g. applied research, regional development).
