A few facts about Lublin



- Lublin is in the south-eastern part of Poland, close to the Ukrainian and Belarussian border. It is the largest city in the Lubelskie County
- In 2012 Lublin airport opened. It is the most modern airport in Poland
- Lublin is a very old city - founded in the 9th century, the city started life as a settlement built around the castle and received town rights in 1317
- Lublin is a real student city, each year it is calculated that 100 000 or so students arrival in the city to study in the 4 universities there
- They call Lublin the “city of inspiration”, in part because of the amazing atmosphere within the city and the number of inspirational ideas and new visions are born there.

A few facts about Poland

- Poland is the member of the EU since 1 May, 2004
- The currency used is zloty, €1 = approx. PLN 4.70
- The population of Poland is approx. 38 mln people
- The capital of Poland is Warsaw



The best way to exchange currency in Poland is to visit a bank, ATM, or Kantor (currency exchange service). Avoid changing at airports, ATMs is a better option there.

Weather in Poland changes all over the year, there are four seasons. Poland is situated in a moderate climate zone. In summer – the temperature varies from 25° to 35° Celsius. The coldest months are January and February with temperatures falling a couple of degrees below zero.

You can expect everything from the weather here. **June is one of the best months to visit Poland. The temperature may vary from 15° to 30° Celsius.**

Travel suggestions

Airports

There are two airports in Warsaw and one smaller airport in Lublin.

- Warsaw Chopin Airport
- Warsaw Modlin Airport
- Lublin Airport



How to get from Warsaw to Lublin:

• BY BUS

The bus will take you both from Warsaw Chopin Airport and Warsaw Modlin Airport directly to the bus station in Lublin.

The price of the bus is about PLN 50. You can buy tickets online or from the bus driver (only in cash and in PLN). The journey takes about 2,5 hours.

• BY TRAIN

The train will take you from Warsaw Central Station (unfortunately, not directly from the airports) to the train station in Lublin.

The price of the train is about PLN 30. You can buy tickets online or in the ticket office. The journey takes about 2,5 hrs.

You can choose a hotel in the vicinity of the beautiful Old Town**

- **Hotel Grodzka 20 ***** (9.2 on Booking)

Offering a restaurant, Hotel Grodzka 20 is located within a historic, renovated house in the Lublin Old Town. The hotel is 200 m to Lublin Castle and 500 m from Sobieski Family Palace. Lublin Plaza Shopping Centre is within 1.4 km. Lublin Airport is 9 km away.

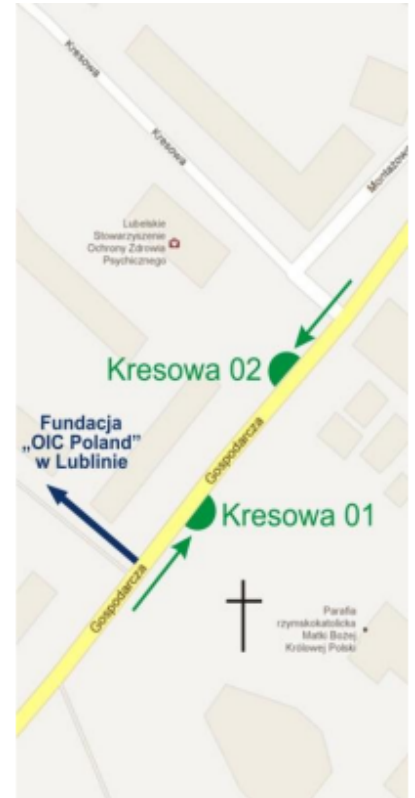


How to get to the meeting venue

You can get to the meeting venue by:

- **public transport**

from the city centre: trolleys no **01, 155, 159**

from the train station: trolleys no **34, 45**

from the bus station: trolleys no **01, 47**

There are ticket machines on the majority of bus stops as well as in the trolleys.

- **taxi**

The Foundation is approximately 3 km from the city centre. You can order a taxi or a Bolt/Uber (popular applications in Poland) which will take you directly to the meeting venue.
