# The project

- **Embedding and Empowering SELFIE WBL Culture**  
(acronym: SELFIE WBL follow-up)
  - **Call:** KA220-VET - Cooperation partnerships in vocational education and training
  - **Duration:** 36 months (November 2021 – October 2024)
  - **Partnership:** SEPR (France), HVC (Slovenia), MDOE (Hungary), OIC (Poland), BBS (Germany), EfVET (Belgium)
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# Background

1<sup>st</sup> strategic priority of 2021-27 Digital Education Action Plan:  
*“development of a high-performing digital education ecosystem”*

Effective digital capacity planning and development is *“vital for education and training systems”*




SELFIE WBL experimentation last year, which highlighted further needs from VET centres

**Main objective of new KA2: answer these needs**

# Evaluation

**Total score: 62/100**

- Quality of the project design and implementation : 11/20
  - Quality of the partnership and cooperation arrangements : 13/20
  - Relevance of the proposal : 19/30
  - Impact : 19/30
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# Evaluator's comments

- PRs and project are not innovative enough
  - MEs planned at the start of project are not relevant
  - Budget is unbalanced between partners, between activities, and not adequate for the proposed PRs
  - Exceptional costs are PMI costs
  - Role of partners and repartition of activities are not explained/justified
  - No newcomer among partners ('upward convergence')
  - No risk management plan
  - Need analysis is not solid, previous project not detailed enough
  - No link between PRs, activities, tasks and objectives
  - Methodology and indicators to measure the results and impact are not detailed enough
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# Budget cuts

Exceptional costs (2000€)

→ Final financial audit is considered PMI cost

Project results n°1; 2; 4; 5 (176.750€)

→ do not correspond to the Erasmus+ program guide rules (p.86):  
“The outputs should be substantial in quality and quantity to qualify for this type of grant support. The outputs should prove their potential for wider use and exploitation, as well as for impact”

Multiplier events n°1 to 4 (8725€)

→ not necessary anymore since we cut some PRs

→ not relevant in M8 / too soon





# What do we have left?

- Project management and implementation: 63,000€
- Transnational project meetings: 35,075€ (≈ 2 people/ institution/ meeting)
- Project results: 71,990€
  - PR3: 31,400€
  - PR6: 40,590€
- Multiplier events: 8,775€
  - ME5: 2,500€
  - ME6: 6,275€
- Exceptional costs: 20,800€
- **TOTAL: 199,640€**
